



Smart Rural Tourism Project

CALL FOR TRAINEES

Università Telematica Pegaso and seven European partners are carrying out the European Erasmus project “Smart Rural Tourism”. The project is aimed to realize a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) concerning the setting up and management of activities in the field of Smart Rural Tourism.

In the present phase, Pegaso is to organise a testing of the training modules developed in cooperation with the partners.

We are therefore selecting approx. 30 trainees/potential users for an online training event.

A condensed pilot course will be delivered in English with an innovative methodology, also open to international participants. The contents that will be delivered, related to the starting up of Smart Rural Tourism activities, are:

Module 1 (Intro)

Module 2 (Strategies and Policies)

Module 3 (ICT)

Module 4 (Sustainability)

Module 5 (Accessibility)

Module 6 (Creativity)

Module 7 (Entrepreneurship).

We therefore invite whoever is interested, to submit their applications to prof. Lorenzo Fiorito, the Project Manager for Pegaso Online University, at international@unipegaso.it, by February 28, 2021.

In the mail, the applicants must include their name, their position as students or other, their motivation to attend the course.

Approximately 30 participants will be selected, divided into 5 teams and contacted at the beginning of March. They will be provided with instructions, specific Team assignment and credentials to join the online sessions (five training sessions of 2 hours each, for a total of 10 hours) in the first half of March. A certificate of attendance will be issued to each participant.

The pilot online training is organised by Università Telematica Pegaso with the support of Pegaso International, Malta, thanks to the collaboration of their academic staffs. To this end, Pegaso International will acknowledge the candidates, upon effective participation in the seminars, with formative credits usable and recognised in its relevant degree courses.
